*These questions can help you prepare some brief words of remembrance for formal Catholic gatherings when a Christian dies, such as the Vigil for the Deceased, the Funeral Liturgy, or the Rite of Committal. These questions can also be used for other informal gatherings when you want to remember and share stories of your deceased loved one's life of faith.*
