ORDER EASTER SUPPLIES

Palms for Palm Sunday.

Paschal Candle.

Candles for parishioners with protectors.

Easter devotional books for parishioners.

Red devotional candles for alternate Tabernacles' lamps.

Three Oils (To be picked up at Diocese Chrism Mass).

Flowers for Altar on Easter.

Carnations for Cross on Good Friday.

Six 2.5 x 17 candles for altar, if needed.

Charcoal and incense, if needed.

Hosts and wine, if needed.

Batteries for microphones, if needed.

No later than the Friday) Prior to Palm Sunday the Church staff and volunteers will prepare the Church for Easter Week by covering the images, statues and crucifix, removing the votive candles, draining the Baptismal Font, and removing the Holy Water bowls from the entrances.

FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT: In the Dioceses of the United States, the practice of covering crosses and images throughout the church from this Sunday may be observed. Crosses remain covered until the end of the Celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday, but images remain covered until the beginning of the Easter Vigil.]
