SET UP FOR EXPOSITION & ADORATION 5/8/2025

If a Mass is scheduled prior, the Sacristan will set-up and clean-up as they normally do, with the <u>exception that the Sacristan will provide two 2 3/4</u> inch hosts for Consecration.

Note: The Presider may request incensing; be prepared.

Before Mass begins, move the Monstrance (meaning: to expose) from its case in the Sacristy closet to the side cabinet in the Sacristy. Using a Presider's purificator wrapped around the stem, place the Monstrance on the credence table with the purificator still wrapped.

Remove a kneeler from the confessional room and place it in front of the front right side middle pew.

After the Sign of Peace, the EMHC (adult Altar Server) will transfer the ciborium and luna from the Tabernacle to the Altar.

If a second/new 2 3/4 inch Host was Consecrated at the Mass, the Presider will replace the older Host in the luna with the new one and place the older Host in the ciborium for distribution.

Immediately after Communion place the kneeler at the base of the Altar steps.

After the Final Blessing, if needed, clear the Altar with the exception of the Corporal. Using the purificator, place the Monstrance on the Altar, to the right side of the corporal, facing your left. Slide the corporal forward, without lifting it, to the middle of the Altar. Then be seated.

Optional: Move the Divine Mercy painting from the rear Sacristy and lean it against the lectern corner, facing the middle of the pews.

At this time the Presider will initiate Adoration.

After Adoration (typically around noon) the Presider (or Sacristan if requested) will remove the Host from the Monstrance and return it to the

Tabernacle. The Sacristan then extinguishes the Altar candles, locks the Tabernacle, returns the Monstrance to its case in the Sacristy and into the closet, the Tabernacle key to the Sacristy cabinet, the painting to the rear Sacristy, and the kneeler to the confessional room.
